

LIMITED LICENSE REQUIREMENTS FOR ALCOHOL AND DRUG RELATED OFFENSES

EFFECTIVE May 12, 2009

Original sanction period extended for a minimum of three years.

Be violation free for at least one year to be eligible for limited license.

NEEDED FOR HEARING

Written verification for the person's primary care physician that:

- To the physician's knowledge the person had not used any narcotic drug or other controlled substance except as prescribed by a licensed medical practitioner within the last three years; and
- The physician is not aware of any physical, emotional, or mental impairment that would affect the person's ability to operate a motor vehicle safely

A letter from the last convicting judge for a violation of a traffic law that resulted the last extension of the person's original sanction period

A letter from the employer outlining the work schedule for the person if limited driving privileges are being requested to commute to and from work

A copy of the class schedule for the person if limited driving privileges are being requested to commute to and from school

BEFORE LICENSE IS ISSUED

Clear all outstanding indefinite department actions

Pay all reinstatement fees

Pay licensing fees

Complete required testing
